The Board of Stewards at Bluff Park UMC is comprised of over seventy leaders in our church. The purpose of this board is to oversee, align and evaluate the ministries and missions of our congregation. This board also serves as the administrative agency of the Charge Conference, the main voting body of our church.

Last night, our Board of Stewards met for the first time in 2014 and made some wonderful decisions for our church. Here are some of the things on the horizon for Bluff Park this

year:

- 1. Our church has adopted a \$1.517 million dollar budget for this year. This budget includes several investments such as \$25,000 for our Chile Mission Trip, new staff for Finance and Communication, as well as a 1% raise for our staff. You will be hearing more about our budget in the coming month.
- 2. We heard updates from the Building Team and how we are moving forward with research on a new Fellowship Hall and youth and children space.
- 3. We heard the report from Ministry Architects, the consulting firm that did an assessment of our Children's and Family Ministries. The board approved using this consulting firm for an intensive coaching program for 18 months to help us provide excellent structure and ministry for our children.
- 4. We heard a report from the Trustees who voted to use the generous gift from the estate of a church member to build an outdoor pavilion and green space for us all to use and enjoy right here on our church property.
- 5. We announced two new mission initiatives this year. One is to raise just over \$8,000 for Imagine No Malaria which combats malaria in Africa with education, treatment and prevention. Our Bishop has challenged every church in North Alabama to raise money for this mission and if every church does its part, we will raise \$1 million dollars and save 100,000 lives. Bluff Park will save 800 lives this year alone if we meet our goal.
- 6. Our second mission initiative is to build a Habitat for Humanity home this year. Each Habitat home costs about \$50,000 to build and thanks to the work of our own Tom Duley and Jim McCrary, \$25,000 will come from the Community Foundation of Greater Birmingham. Then, thanks to a generous anonymous member of our congregation who agreed to give \$15,000 to this project, we already have \$40,000 at this point. Our goal is to raise \$15,000 so that we have an additional \$5,000 with which to cover any unforeseen expenses as well as to provide housewarming gifts for the family who will live in the home.

As you can see, we have many things to be excited about this year! We had several other important reports and happenings, but we might take the whole newsletter in order to report those. Please know that we have leaders in this congregation that are committed to helping all of us to love God, to love others, and to change the world.

Here's to the possibilities this year as we live out God's dream here at Bluff Park UMC!
