A WORD FROM THE PASTOR

This Sunday, we will begin our Lenten sermon series with words of grace and forgiveness. Jesus, painfully hanging upon the Roman cross, looks at the centurions (Roman soldiers) and the religious leaders from the Temple and speaks aloud: "Father, forgive them for they know not what they do."

Jesus speaks those words to people who were brutally cruel to him. However, the Church has also taught over the centuries that Jesus also speaks those words to all Christians of all time. We all need God's forgiveness. We all have fallen short, and keep trying to pick ourselves up. We all have failed to be obedient, but have tried to go our own way. We have not kept God as our Lord but have turned needlessly to idols.


Jesus speaks words of forgiveness to us all before we were even born. What does this say about the very heart and the unique mission of Jesus Christ? This is our topic for the first Sunday of Lent. Join us in morning worship!
