It is Holy Week at Bluff Park UMC. We waved palm branches in worship yesterday and we are preparing worship experiences on Maundy Thursday and Good Friday both at 7:00 pm. These services will be meaningful and contemplative and hopefully they will help you prepare your heart, mind and soul for Easter Sunday.

On Easter morning, we will hear the Good News that Jesus Christ rose from the dead. Scholars like former Bishop of Durham, Tom Wright, suggest that these Easter stories are so unlike other religious writings at the time and even before that time. They are unique. Wright believes that this points to their validity.

The disciples shared the news that Jesus of Nazareth who had died a tragic death upon a cross had now risen on the third day. People were amazed that these once frightened followers were now speaking with conviction and passion. What changed?

Many have concluded that when the surprise of resurrection became real to Mary and the disciples, they realized that Jesus was truly the Messiah -- the promised one from God. They also came to realize over time that nothing any longer will have the final word for our lives. Not sin, not evil, not hate, nor hurt, wounds, suffering, tragedy -- not even death. The only final words left are hope, joy and life.

That's the power of Easter.


