This Sunday is Palm Sunday, but it is also known as Passion Sunday. The focus is primarily upon Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem on the Sunday prior to his arrest, trial and crucifixion. Jesus enters Jerusalem from the Mount of Olives – entering like a king returning victoriously from battle.

We will have palm branches and triumphant hymns, but then for our sermon this Sunday we will turn back to the cross for the two last sayings of Jesus: "It is finished" and "Into your hands I commit my spirit." We are at the end of this journey through Jesus' sayings upon the cross. We know what happens, but it is not yet the time for that. We must keep near the cross until Sunday morning, April 20th.

Jesus' final statements are not words of defeat, although they may seem as such. They are words of victory – the same sentiment of victory from Palm Sunday. The king's work is now complete and the battle is now over. **Love is finally defeating death.**
