

This Sunday we are thinking about the fourth dimension of abundant living: grace filled meals. Many of Jesus last moments on earth were spent having meals with his disciples. He celebrated the Passover meal on the last night of his life. During this meal he instituted what we know as the Lord's Supper or Holy Communion. In the Gospel of Luke one of the last things Jesus did before he ascended into heaven was to share a meal with

two of his disciples in the village of Emmaus.

They were indeed grace filled meals for Jesus' early disciples. The grace that was present in both of those meals was the grace of recognition. Through those meals the disciples were able to recognize who Jesus was. During the Lord's Supper Jesus took bread and said, "this is my body." He also took wine and said, "this is my blood." The grace of recognition. During the meal in Emmaus we are told that the disciples recognized Jesus in the breaking of the bread. Again, the grace of recognition.

When we partake of Holy Communion it is a grace filled meal for us just as it was for those early disciples. The grace of recognition is available to us through this holy meal just as it was for them. That makes all the difference because when we recognize Jesus for who he is we are able to see our true selves. The abundant life is life filled with the Spirit of Christ. It is the life of Christ come alive in us. The grace of recognition which we experience in Holy Communion helps us to recognize Jesus and ourselves. It is the grace necessary for the abundant life.
