uring the season of Lent, our church family began a new spiritual discipline by committing to daily Scripture reading and daily prayer. We have heard very positive reviews about our Leap of Faith daily prayer journal. One person even remarked that they were thankful to have a tool that helped them to set a time to focus on God and prayer each day. Some even mentioned that their day went better when they started in prayer and reflection than if they missed a day. At first, I personally found it difficult to set a specific time each day to stop, reflect and pray. However, when I was intentional to do so, I found that I became more in harmony with God and others in the process. My prayers led me to better decisions and more faithful actions towards others.

We are planning to continue to offer this prayer journal to our church family and the time to sign up is now! You can go to our website to register (www.bluffparkumc.org). Or you can even download a PDF version of the prayer journal now! These journals are free of charge and they are a wonderful way to grow in prayer and devotion to God. This summer, we are making a few changes to the study. The first is that we are providing a daily prayer focus and that will be included in the reflection questions each day. Secondly, we will be changing the shared prayer more frequently so that we will all be engaged in prayers that match the things that are going on in the life of our church family.

If you are looking for a daily devotional and not a daily prayer journal, we encourage you to stop by the Welcome Desk in the Narthex where the Upper Room daily devotional is available. We highly recommend this United Methodist devotional that is written by people from all over the globe. We would even be happy to recommend a new Study Bible to go along with either daily spiritual growth plan.


May the peace and love of Jesus Christ work through these daily practices to touch your hearts and prepare you for the journey!
