

## Malaria's Dirty Dozen

Fact Two: Malaria, from the Italian mal aria (bad air) is a mosquito-borne disease caused by a parasite. Malaria symptoms include fever, chills, and flu-like illness. Without treatment, malaria victims develop severe complications and die. In 2010 there were about 219 million cases of malaria worldwide, with 627,000 people dying. Most of these deaths (91%) were young children in sub-Saharan Africa.
