Malaria's Dirty Dozen

Eight: While an effective vaccine and new drugs are being developed, what tools are available now to combat malaria? One proven resource is the insecticide-treated net (ITN). Only pyrethroid insecticides are approved for use on ITNs because they pose low health risks to humans and other animals but are toxic to insects even at low doses. One challenge with ITNs is the need to periodically retreat them with insecticides (every 6-12 months or after washing), Some companies have developed long-lasting insecticide-treated nets (LLINs) that maintain effectiveness for up to 3 years, even after washing. The CDC is testing several LLINs to assess performance and durability and WHO has recommended free distribution of LLINs where malaria is endemic.
