On Sunday evening, we officially began our campaign to raise \$25,000 for Imagine No Malaria. As a congregation, we have pledged to raise \$25,000 over the next three years to help prevent, treat and eradicate malaria from the continent of Africa. The global United Methodist Church is seeking to raise \$75 million by the end of 2015 and the North Alabama Conference of the United Methodist Church has pledged to raise \$1 million dollars. The number that has been in my mind ever since we began studying about malaria earlier this year is that \$10 saves one life. If we think about it this way, at the end of our campaign, we will have saved 2500 lives! You will hear more very soon about how you can help give to this important campaign.

Next we want to remind you about our upcoming "God Questions" sermon series where we will be studying two burning questions that people have when talking about God:

- 1. Does everything happen for a reason?
- 2. Where is God when I need him?

#### It's Time to Make a Difference

On Sunday, August 24th, Mrs. Jane Robinson came to share her experiences doing short-term mission work in Africa. She opened our eyes to the devastation malaria visits on the people in Africa and also marked the beginning of our Imagine No Malaria campaign.

On Wednesday, September 3rd Dr. Magdalena Paczkowski, an Epidemic Intelligence Service Officer with the Centers For Disease Control in Atlanta, will join us to give a deeper understanding of the challenges that need to be overcome to end malaria in Africa.

Dr. Paczkowski's presentation will be the kick-off for our fall midweek ministries. Dinner will be served from 5:00pm to 6:30pm. Dr. Paczkowski's presentation will be in the Chapel beginning at 6:30pm.

Next, we must each decide how we will respond to the needs of those in Africa suffering from the devastating impact of malaria.
