We began 2015 with a new sermon series called "Dysfunctional Families of the Old Testament." This past Sunday, as we looked at the dysfunction of Adam and Eve, each blaming one another for their own actions. The two people who were literally made for each other turned against each other at the time of crisis.

This Sunday, we are turning to the next vital family in the book of Genesis, Abram and Sarai. Yes, they will eventually undergo a name change to Abraham and Sarah, but as we are introduced to them in the twelfth chapter of Genesis, they still have their original names. As they move into the land promised to them by God in that same chapter, a crisis arises. Famine covers the land and so they go to the place you normally go when a famine occurs: Egypt.

However, we shall see that sometimes we act in dysfunctional ways when a crisis arises. One key to remember in any crisis is this: Remember who you are. When we have our backs against the wall, we might forget the standard to which we are called to live because of our faith. We might act in ungodly ways, and we might feel justified in doing so because of the nature of the crisis. We must remember who we are. You are God's child. Together we are God's children. How we live, during the good times and the bad, is of the utmost importance to how others encounter and understand God.

A New Year of MidWeek Ministry

A new year of MidWeek Ministry activities has already begun. This is an exciting time and an important part of the life of this congregation. In addition to our weekly meal time, we have a number of learning opportunities. The Pastor's Bible Study at 4:30pm resumes and continues to explore the book of Revelation. A second class which has been added will take place at 6:30pm starting at chapter one. Disciple 1 continues in the evening and we are starting a Screamfree parenting seminar, a special social action seminar on The Church and People with Disabilities, and a preparation class for the upcoming Chile mission trip. In addition to these new learning opportunities, we continue to have activities for the kids, Youth Worship, choir rehearsals, and Prayer Shawl Ministry, or you can just hang out and have a little coffee and conversation.
