On Sunday, March 15th, the Board of Stewards met and unanimously adopted Bluff Park UMC's 2015 annual budget. We are budgeting to receive more in revenue than we spend. How could this be? It is because of the generosity of our church members! During the two State of the Church meetings in February and March, we informed the congregation about the situation we, as a church family, found ourselves in. We have wonderful and excitINGministries and missions that touch so many, and yet, we experienced a forecasted loss of revenue in 2015. In response, over 70 families in our congregation either pledged, increased their pledge, or gave one-time gifts of over \$100,000. This is truly a miracle.

At this same meeting, we elected a new Church Treasurer, John Whitcomb. We

announced the addition of a new Director of Children's Ministries, Stanley Davidson. Stanley will begin in ministry at Bluff Park in May, and will be bring a new energy to our ministries with children. He and his wife will be moving from north Georgia to Birmingham with their young son, Gavin. They are excited to join us in ministry, and we are excited to have Stanley join the pastoral team this summer.

Finally, I want to remind you that Palm Sunday and Easter Sunday are around the corner. We are planning exciting worship services, both Sundays, for all ages. We hope you will make every effort to be here. Easter Sunday, in particular, is a day in which many neighbors in our community will come and visit our church. Our hope and prayer is that these worship services will provide inspiration and joy to all who attend — and that God's grace and love will be experienced anew by all! We look forward to seeing you during Holy Week.
