he United Methodist Church began as a revival movement led by John Wesley, a priest and educator in the Church of England. He sought to reform the Church of England with this "Methodist" movement and eventually his influence did bring about reform after his passing. This movement did, however, create a new denomination in the colonies

that became the United States under the leadership of Thomas Coke and Francis Asbury.

By the way, did you ever notice that the United Methodist bookstore, Cokesbury, is the combination of the last names of Coke and Asbury? Francis Asbury was said to have come into Northern Alabama and visit churches under his leadership.

One of the many important documents that John Wesley left behind for Method-

ists is a summary called The Character of a Methodist, which sought to solidify for us "our identity as genuine and fruitful disciples and followers of Christ." In it, he says that a Methodist: Loves God, Rejoices in God, Gives thanks, Prays constantly, and Loves others.

As we continue in our sermon series on United Methodism, these five points can be markers for us all as to how we live out our common faith!

HELP THE PEOPLE OF NEPAL

The General Board of Global Ministries of The United Methodist Church, through its disasterrelief arm and in conjunction with longtime local and international partners and Nepal-based Global Ministries missionaries, is responding to the devastating earthquake that rocked Nepal on April 25th.

On April 27th, the United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR), Global Ministries' relief and development unit, approved a grant of \$90,000 for international partner GlobalMedic to bring sorely needed clean water to survivors through provision of household and public water-filtration units.

Global Ministries has been in mission with the people of Nepal for a long time and this relationship will be an avenue of blessing for the disaster response in the area. All five Global Ministries missionaries serving in Nepal, and their families, have reported that they are safe.
