e at Bluff Park United Methodist hope that all of you had a blessed Memorial Day weekend, and that you were able to spend time in reflection and develop a spirit of thanksgiving for the ways in which God almighty, as well as many others in military service, have sacrificed out of care and concern for us all. As summer begins, we will celebrate Trinity Sunday as we acknowledge the great mystery that God is three in one (Father, Son and Holy Spirit). The concept of Trinity is a defining characteristic for Christianity and divides us from other Abrahamic faiths such as Judaism and Islam. Both of these other faiths say that, as the Shema in Deuteronomy 6 declares, "the Lord our God, the Lord is one." They take that word "one" literally. Christians understand that God is still one, but has three expressions as God the

Father, God the Son, displayed in Jesus Christ, and God the Holy Spirit as we discussed this past Sunday.

The gift of the Trinity is that the one, true God does not stand separated from you and I in heaven. The "triune" God was able to be present within human history in the life of Jesus and continues to be present to you and me through the Holy Spirit. Still, the concept is tricky to understand and even more difficult to teach. This Sunday, we will turn to Isaiah 6:1-8 as we read the familiar words of Isaiah being empowered by God to speak on his behalf. Isaiah courageously responds: "Here I am, send me." How could Isaiah be so bold as to speak on behalf of God?

I believe the answer lies in the Trinity. God empowers people like Isaiah, as well as folks like you and me, with gifts and graces. At the same time, God empowers us all with the presence of himself in the Holy Spirit. In a sense, God is with us each and every step of the way. In all of your steps this summer, remember that the Holy Spirit goes with you!

## **Providing Clean Water**

The village of Kako, in the Indian state of Bihar, now has access to clean water. Approximately 32 families will draw water from a new well created with the help of Bluff Park UMC Members. The New Light Sunday School class led the effort to raise the money for this project, which included last year's Fun Run. Combined with a contribution from the Easter Love Gift, we were able to fund the drilling of this new well.

The project was done in partnership with Neverthirst, a non-profit organization dedicated to providing access to clean water in communities around the world. This new well and pump replaces the village's open well which used to get contaminated frequently with surface runoff during heavy rains. Thank you to the New Light Sunday School class and everyone who helped to make this possible.
