By ishop Debra Wallace-Padgett announced at this year's Annual Conference of the North Alabama United Methodist Church that the Methodists of North Alabama raised over \$1,000,000 to combat malaria in Africa. Bluff Park UMC played a significant role in reaching this goal as we are currently working to raise \$25,000 by the end of 2016. The good news is that we are already more than halfway there! Thanks to individual donations as well as a gift from our annual Legacy Gala Silent Auction, we have raised over \$16,000 to date! Bishop Wallace-Padgett told us that in raising the \$1 million dollars, we will save 100,000 lives through malaria-related education, prevention and medical care. Two-thousand, five hundred of those lives saved will be because of your generosity.

Bluff Park UMC has always been a life-giving, life-building church. Our mission focus for the past year aims to continue this work. Our wonderful Missions Committee chose to make our missional focus as follows: "Food, Water, Shelter." Our monthly missions such as the Food Pantry and the Under the Bridge Ministry are feeding the hungry. The well that was dug in India by NeverThirst, thanks to the work of this congregation though the New Light Sunday School class, is giving drink to the thirsty. And our work with Habitat and our youth mission trip to ASP are helping provide shelter to the those without.

Each and everyone of us is called to consider how we can provide life – provide food, water and shelter – for others. This summer as you notice the thermometer climb, remember those without access to fresh water or appropriate shelter. This summer as you enjoy a July 4th picnic, remember those who have nothing to eat, and as individuals, and as families, think about how you can provide regular access to these important life needs. It can be as simple as carrying bottled water and snacks in your car, or as easy as providing necessary food items to our Food Pantry; or it could be as big as asking your Sunday School class to take on your own mission initiative. Whatever it is, seek to give LIFE to others, just as God provides life to each of us.

Bluff Park UMC is launching an important new ministry and you are invited to be a part of it. We are making a focused effort to reach out to the veterans in our community with special attention for those returning from service during the War On Terror. 
