n July 26, 2015, the Board of Stewards at Bluff Park UMC adopted the following purpose statement for our church.

PURPOSE STATEMENT: Bluff Park United Methodist Church exists to make disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world around us. We seek to guide, develop, and nurture persons to deepen their faith and service to God through vibrant worship and dynamic opportunities for learning, growth, and life-giving mission.
