n last week's newsletter, we unveiled Bluff Park UMC's new Purpose Statement. It so beautifully states who we are and what we should do as a corporate church family. Today, I would like to share with you the church's new Vision Statement that was adopted by the Board of Stewards on July 26, 2015. It is important to understand that the Purpose Statement drives who we are and how we operate. The Vision Statement is more about how we will try to minister to our people and to our community. This Vision Statement is exciting and I think it will give our Vision Steering Team wonderful space for creativity in what new and renewed ministries and missions can come from this statement:

VISION STATEMENT: Bluff Park United Methodist Church seeks to be a community creating relational experiences that help all people find life and know through a relationship with God: who they are, why they matter, and how to serve the world in love.

I hope you notice that this Vision Statement is more about how our church can influence and transform the lives of all people that we reach. We want to be a church that creates open and inviting experiences that help people find the life that they desire (which we believes comes only from God). We want to be a church together that helps people develop a dynamic relationship with God, that helps them understand themselves as a child of God – a child who matters deeply to Him as well as to others in the Church, and we want to be a serving church that inspires and equips all people to serve the world in some form or capacity (which is our vocation as Christians "in the meantime" as Angela reminded us this past Sunday).

We have tried to sum up this vision with a short easy-to-remember phrase that will accompany our logo: Seek God, Lose Yourself, Find Life. As always, I would appreciate feedback, questions, and even ideas as we move forward with our Purpose and Vision Statements!
