lmost twenty years ago, I attended the Walk to Emmaus; a 72-hour retreat that focuses on spiritual renewal. If you remember the story of the walk to Emmaus from the 24th chapter of Luke, you know this was the occasion just after the resurrection where two disciples were walking between Jerusalem and Emmaus, talking over the events of the past few days when they were joined by a stranger. As they sat around the table that evening, as the "stranger" broke and blessed the bread, their eyes were opened and they recognized the stranger as Jesus. (Luke 24:13-35)

If you desire spiritual renewal, if you long to learn about God's grace in such a way that it allows you to recognize Jesus in a way you might never have before, I encour-

age you to attend an Emmaus retreat.

The retreat includes 15 talks that are given by lay people and clergy on the themes of God's grace, disciplines of Christian discipleship, and what it means to be the church. The course is wrapped in prayer and meditation, special times of worship, and daily celebration of Holy Communion. The "Emmaus community", made up of those who have attended the weekend, support the experience with a prayer vigil, by preparing and serving meals, and other acts of love and self-giving. ("What is Emmaus", Stephen Bryant)

I've never known anyone who attended the Walk to Emmaus to be disappointed; in fact, quite the opposite is true. People return with a joy and enthusiasm to serve that did not exist before. They are excited about their own discipleship, and helping others see Jesus in a renewed way. I loved my experience and believe that you would too! Pray and consider attending your own walk.
