For the past three weeks, the Stewardship Committee which is led by Joe Campbell has been demonstrating in worship the vast array of missions, ministries and programs at Bluff Park UMC. New Children's Church Format

On Sunday, October 25th, we will offer Children's Church in a brand new way! All Kindergarten thru 5th grade students are invited to a children's worship service on non-communion Sundays that will begin immediately following the Prayer of Confession in both our 8:45 and 11:00 worship services. Children who would like to attend will be led by Mr. Stanley, and a volunteer to Hudson Hall, where they will participate in a worship service geared toward them at their age and level. This worship service will consist of prayer, hymns, offering, a children's sermon, and life application of that sermon. The children will then be led by Mr. Stan-



ley and a volunteer back to the Narthex, where they can be picked up as their parents/grandparents exit the sanctuary. It is our hope and prayer that this way of offering Children's Church will be more spiritually nourishing and exciting than the way it is currently offered. We hope to see all the children there!

In order to abide by the Safe Sanctuary Policy of our church, we are in need of one adult volunteer for each session of Children's Church. This person will assist Mr. Stanley in crowd control and leading the worship service. There is no pre-planning required for this volunteer spot.
