Over time, the church grew in facilities, in attendance, and in our scope of mission and outreach. Today, we stand on the shoulders of those generations who provided for us and for our community. Their faith in God through Jesus Christ inspired and challenged them to be the kind of people who created such a won-

derful church.

In order to be faithful to this story, we must continue to be faithful to God. We must continue to be inspired and challenged to grow in our love of God, and to deepen our own spiritual maturity while also serving our neighbor. Last week, we shared in our Facebook Page online how our church is carrying on the story that brought us to where we are today. We shared on Tuesday, October 20th that because of the generosity of our church, we were able to help a single mother with her utilities. We also provided a space to about one hundred singers from the community to share their talents. We then shared on Wednesday, October 21st, because of the generosity of our church, we were able to provide ministries to over one hundred children where they could be touched by the love of God. We also provided pastoral care with our members in the hospital. Finally, we were able to provide groceries for a family of seven. Then on Thursday, October 22nd, we were able to provide a space for senior adults from across Birmingham to come together in learning and fellowship at the Shepherd's Center. We were also able to bless an expectant mother in our community with a gift card to a store so that she could purchase clothes, food and other items for her child.
