n Sunday, November 15th, we held our second State of the Church meeting of 2015. We shared on Sunday evening that our financial revenue from January to October is dramatically better than the same time frame last year. We are also off to a very good start with out 2016 Stewardship Campaign with 230 pledges already in during the first three weeks of our campaign. We believe that there are at least seventy more families that are about to turn in their 2016 pledge. If you are one of those households, please know that with each and every pledge turned in we are closer to being able to begin new ministries both within our congregation as well as outside the walls of the church in mission as well. While we have not yet reached the end

of the 2015 fiscal year, or the end of the 2016 Stewardship Campaign, where we are now is very encouraging!

With Thanksgiving just a week away, we, as people of faith, gather around our collected tables and give thanks to God for all that He is and for all that He has provided for us. During this Thanksgiving, I am particularly thankful for the people of our congregation who have allowed their generosity to flow both into the ministries of the Church as well as out of the walls of the Church into the community and world. To the moment of my writing this article, we have collected 113 blankets for the homeless, about 200 canned hams for those who are seeking food assistance, and we have chosen to provide toys and gifts for 120 children in the Birmingham area this Christmas.

I am blessed to be a pastor in a congregation that cares deeply about our future and for the needs of the community around us. May God bless you and your families this Thanksgiving.

COMMUNITY THANKSGIVING WORSHIP SERVICE


