This is a special time of year when we place the Chrismon tree in the Sanctuary along with the Advent Wreath and many other signs of Advent and Christmas. Technically, the season of Advent is the beginning of a new year in the life of each liturgically-centered church. Our new year begins with four Sundays looking forward to the coming or arrival of the Christ child. In that way, Advent is the time of preparing our hearts, our minds, and our congregations to receive God's great gift of His own self...His own Son...for us.

In our celebration of Advent this year, we will focus on the way in which God invested Himself into His creation. We read in the Scriptures that God chose to gift His Son to us in order to grant us grace, grant us His divine presence, and to correct our paths. Much like in the season of Lent where we are asked to consider how our lives are either in tune, or out of tune with God, Advent is also a time for self-reflection.

We will be inviting our congregation to consider one main question: What are we putting out into the world? When Jesus Christ was born, joy spread like wildfire. Good news was proclaimed throughout the region. Are we passing along joy and good news in our lives? If not, this Advent is a time for us to recommit to living in God's reality instead of slipping into the world striving to exist without Him.

We begin the season of Advent with hope as we light the first candle of the Advent wreath. That is fitting isn't it? For it is by hope and by faith that we gain the courage to fully commit to God's kingdom and to God's future for us all.
