sh Wednesday falls on February 10th this year and this important day in the life of the Church marks the beginning of the season of Lent. Many of us are familiar with Shrove Tuesday (or Fat Tuesday) where people around the world feast and celebrate the day before Ash Wednesday. This is because the season of Lent is often seen as a time of self-denial and of spiritual focus. It is a time to wrestle with our own temptations and shortcomings. Really, what this means is that Lent is a time of growth: growth in our relationship with God and growth in the way we live our lives. Sadly, some Christians only practice these steps towards God during the 40 days of Lent and then the lessons learned during that journey are put away for the next year.

During this Lenten season, we are challenging each and every member of our church family to make an intentional commitment to grow in your relationship with God as well as in your growth as a disciple of Jesus Christ. What this requires is for you to register for our "Leap of Faith" Spiritual Formation Plan. You may do so either on our website, or in the main office, or even at the Welcome Center in the Narthex on a Sunday morning. During the season of Lent, each person who registers will have the opportunity to read a daily Scripture, practice daily prayer in a prayer journal, and discover ways in which to connect in learning and service through our church.

I am so excited about this plan because I deeply believe that each and every one of us can benefit from an intentional commitment to turn towards God.

This plan does not end on Easter Sunday, but will continue through the Spring. Our hope is to continue to offer these types of opportunities for spiritual growth throughout the year. Please join me in registering for the "Leap of Faith" Spiritual Formation Plan!


14TH ANNUAL ORGAN RE-CITAL

EASTER EGG HUNT HELP: Our annual Children's Easter Egg Hunt and Breakfast will be held on Saturday, March 19th from 9-11. This year, one of our goals is to invite as many children from the community as possible! Because of this, we have set an ambitious goal of collecting and hiding 8000 Easter Eggs at the hunt, and we need your help! Our plan is to collect half of the Easter Eggs (4000) the way our church has traditionally collected them: bags of plastic eggs can be picked up at both entrances on the first floor or in the Narthex, stuffed with candy by those who pick them up, and returned to the same spots when completed. In the hopes of honoring any of our guests who might have allergies of any kind, we would like to purchase the other 4000 Easter Eggs online from a website that will deliver prestuffed candy and toy filled eggs to our church. If you would like to help, you can do so in one of two ways: bags of Easter Eggs can be picked up starting this Sunday, February 7th, and monetary donations for helping us offset the price of purchasing Easter Eggs online can be made out to BPUMC with "Easter Eggs" placed in the memo line.
