he word "catechumen" is not one that you might hear brought up very often in our church, but it is still a part of who we are as Christians particularly in this season of Lent. We began the journey through the Lenten season on Ash Wednesday as many of us were marked by the ashes. This journey goes back to at least the year 325 AD, as the Council of Nicea advised churches to commemorate the 40 days leading up to Easter. Eventually, this 40 day season was used to prepare and train new Christians in the faith and way of Jesus. They received instruction and examination and then were baptized at the Easter vigil when they received Holy Communion for the first time. These people preparing to join the church were called "catechumen."

During the general time frame of Lent each year, our Confirmation class convenes each year to receive instruction and examination as they prepare to claim the faith they were baptized into as children. Bart Styes, our Director of Youth Ministry, teaches the sessions and helps each student learn to articulate his or her faith. On April 10th, these young people will officially join our church and profess their faith. I invite you to pray for them as they undergo training and examination in our youth area each and every Sunday morning!

Just as these young people are being trained in the ways of faith, so are the rest of us in our church family. Each of us are called during this holy season to reflect on our own sinfulness as well as our own need for God and His grace. We are also called to reflect on how we can faithfully live for Him each and every day. Are you ready to take the Leap of Faith?
