Easter Love Gift Update

We are a little more than half-way through the season of Lent. And we are a little more than half-way through the time when we receive the Easter Love Gift offering. This is an important part of our mission funding. It allows us to support agencies and ministries locally and internationally. It allows us to support agencies that work in our focus areas of food, water and shelter. Each agency we are supporting this year works in at least of our mission focus areas.

One agency that we are supporting in 2016 is **Stop Hunger Now**. Volunteers from Bluff Park went to Vestavia Hills UMC last year to help pack meals. Through the Easter Love Gift we were also able to help with a financial contribution. We will be doing this again this year. The dates for the event are **April 17-19**. There will be an online sign up process, just as there was last year. When registration opens, we will share details with the congregation. This is a fun mission project that is appropriate for all ages. It is a very family friendly event.

Stop Hunger Now distributes meals through its partner organizations in developing countries around the world. The meals we packed last year were distributed in Haiti. Meals are used to promote education, encourage children to attend school and improve students health and nutrition. Our goal this year is to pack 285,120 meals. This represents one full shipping container. Each nutritious meal costs just \$.29, so it is a great bargain.

This is just one of the important ministries that will be supported by your gift to the Easter Love Gift offering. We have a goal this year of \$30,000. It is an ambitious goal, but we think that it is achievable if we all pull together. To date we have received \$7,674. If you haven't given already please pray about doing so. No gift is too small or too large and 100% of what you give will be used to support the work of the agencies we have chosen.
