n Sunday, we will gather together in worship and sing and shout a certain word together, while children wave palm branches. That word is "Hosanna!" This word has great significance on Palm Sunday, which we will celebrate together on March 20th. So many years ago, a large crowd gathered along the road waving palm branches to greet Jesus as he entered into Jerusalem during the festival of Passover. They greeted Jesus as a kingly figure or at least as a revolutionary who might be able to free them from Roman oppression and rule. Hosanna literally means "Save Now!" This large crowd hopes that Jesus is entering into Jerusalem to begin the process of saving God's people.

When we celebrate Palm Sunday together, we do as saved people. We are the very people that God through Jesus Christ saved from slavery to sin and death. Others cried out Hosanna! for themselves and we are the beneficiaries. This Palm Sunday, I invite you to consider who Jesus could save next. Is there a situation or a group of people that need healing or restoration or even liberation? Will you pray Hosanna! for them? Let us join together in worship to wave our palm branches, adorn our garments with palm crosses, and pray Hosanna for those in need.
