# Risen: Encounters with the Resurrected Jesus

Did you know that the season of Easter lasts for fifty days leading up to Pentecost Sunday (which is May 15, 2016)? According to Christian tradition, the initial purpose of these fifty days was "to continue the faith formation of new Christians." Instead of celebrating the Resurrection of Jesus Christ on one Sunday, we celebrate for seven Sundays in a row.

During the time in-between that first Easter and the ascension of Jesus, Christ visited with his disciples and other friends. These visitations are documented in the Gospels and in the Book of Acts. Rev. Angela Martin so beautifully described the first encounter that Jesus has with Mary at the tomb this past Sunday. Mary does

not initially recognize Jesus, but she knows his voice. While several see the empty tomb itself, Mary sees the risen Jesus first.

During the Sundays of Easter in worship, we will be studying these visitations as Jesus appears to his disciples behind a locked door or as he appears to doubting Thomas reveals his wounds or as he breaks bread with lesser known disciples on their way to Emmaus. These visitations reveal the wonder of the Resurrection and the power it had over those whom knew Jesus the best. We hope you will join us during Eastertide in worship!
