n the winter of 2015 and 2016, Bluff Park UMC was invited by the Office of New Church Development of the North Alabama Conference of the United Methodist Church to participate in a new covenant which places additional associate pastors in healthy and strategic churches to start new ministries and new worship services. Our church was contacted and invited to participate in this new program. We have for many years dreamed of becoming more faithful in reaching and ministering to young adults in our community (which is a growing population in Bluff Park as young families are moving into our neighborhood). Our Staff Parish Relations Committee decided to partner with the Annual Conference in this covenant and the Finance Committee and the Board of Stewards sup-

ported this decision. On this past Sunday, we announced in worship that as part of this new covenant, Rev. John Carl Hastings will be joining our staff this coming June.

As a part of this covenant, Rev. Hastings will receive salary support from both our church and from the Annual Conference for at least three years. He will be charged with working with the young adults already active in our church as well as to make new connections in our community as well. He will also be receiving further training and coaching from the Office of New Church Development. Over time, he will be working with a team of our members looking into adding an additional worship service which hopes to reach new people. The plans for that new worship service have not yet begun as we are waiting to assemble that team and to access the needs of the community first.

I can tell you that I personally am thrilled with the choice that our Bishop made in sending Rev. Hastings to us. The Annual Conference has affirmed his gifts and he has been approved for Full Connection as an Elder in our conference. But beyond that, I know him to be a passionate follower of Jesus Christ who is excited to do something new and innovative for the sake of the Kingdom of God! I invite you to begin praying for John Carl and his family as they begin to end their ministries in the Southwest District and prepare to move to Birmingham for a new chapter in their lives. His first Sunday will be June 26, 2016.

John Carl Hastings is currently the pastor of Hargrove Memorial and St. Paul UMCs in Tuscaloosa. A graduate of Auburn University and The Divinity School at Duke University, John Carl is married to the Rev. Tori Hastings, who currently serves Druid Hills and Holt UMCs in Tuscaloosa and will be appointed to Canterbury UMC in June. Together, they have a ten-month-old son, Brooks, and an impossibly energetic miniature dachshund, Gracie. John Carl is passionate about ministry, particularly in the areas of preaching and worship. He loves helping people enter into communion with God, one another, and the world and feels that we are most at home when we are fellow-shipping around God's Table. He looks forward to serving alongside all the people of Bluff Park UMC and is eager to join in with the good work that God is doing in the Bluff Park community.
