# "Our country is hemorrhaging, literally, and drastic triage is required."

United Methodist pastor, James Howell, wrote these words this week about the tragedy in Orlando, Florida, on Sunday. Over 100 people were killed or wounded in this act of terror and hate. In the midst of a tragedy like this, that should not have ever happened, we want answers and action. We look to our leaders to explain the reasons why something like this happened as well as to tell us what they are going to do in order to prevent this kind of thing from ever happening again.

Online we have seen people pray and lament. We have seen people lecture and criticize. I have been moved by some of the posts almost as much as I have been

troubled by the words of others. Last month, according to news outlets, a spokesman for ISIS stated that so-called homegrown terrorists should act and terrorize Americans "so that the neighbor fears his neighbor." Notice that the end result that ISIS hopes to achieve is for the people of the United States to live in a state of distrust and fear. And in the process of living within this state, we would then turn on one another.

Jesus emphasized both praying for our enemies and loving our neighbor, which seem to be even more difficult to do at times like these. But they are even more necessary. We must learn to pray and we must learn to stay connected with our neighbors and to live in peace. This itself will free us from becoming seized by fear. And then we must turn to God, fervently asking God to help us to stop the hemorrhaging of people and our country.


