astor and author John Stott says that for any church to be a "living church," it must also be a learning church. He points out that the Acts of the Apostles states that early Christians "devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching" (Acts 2:42). These early Christians understood that the pursuit of understanding as it relates to God and His revelation to us is of the utmost importance. I know in my own life, the study of the Scriptures and learning about how the faith is being lived by others has helped me to creatively analyze how I should live my own life in relation to God and His purposes.

Sunday school classes are a great starting point for this kind of learning. All of our Sunday morning classes have wonderful teachers and lively discussion about the Scriptures and about relevant topics in Christianity today. If you are ready to join a Sunday morning class, please contact the church office and our pastors will be able to assist you! In addition to Sunday morning learning, we also offer small groups and Bible studies on Wednesday evenings and Sunday evenings and details about these classes is in the Fall 2016 Mission and Ministry Guide. Several of our classes are already filling up, but a few others still have room and we would love for you to find a place to plug in and grow.

Our plan for this fall as a church family is to offer three different styles of learning opportunities to our church. The first are Discover Groups which include Sunday school classes and traditional Bible studies. Next, we are offering Life Groups which include walking and running groups, healthy eating classes and a parenting class. Finally, we are hoping to start several Grow Groups which are brand new to our church family. These groups of 6-12 people meet together to study together, pray together and build one another up in faith and life. If you would like to participate in one of these pilot groups, please let one of the pastors know!
