his is the final week of our 10,000 Reasons, 1,500 Pieces, One Vision series and everything leads up to Commitment Sunday next week. On October 30th, each person in worship will have the opportunity to bring their commitments forward both for the annual budget of our church as well as for the threeyear capital campaign for our new building. This new building will house our youth ministry and a new gymnasium. Classrooms and a large worship space will provide our students with a vibrant and clean new space for them to grow in faith and service. The new gymnasium will provide people in our community with greater access to recreational space and potential new community ministries. As you have heard, we have 10,000 reasons for us to move forward with this plan - one reason for every household in our surrounding community.

During this series, we have been looking to the Sermon on the Mount where Jesus looks to his followers to become the very people who reflect the way and truth of God to the world. This calling from Jesus is both exciting and daunting. As a church family, we bear this calling together.

Together, as a church united around one vision, we can both continue the witness we are already reflecting to our community while also adding new ways to bless our young people and the wider community. Together we the pieces of the body of Christ known as Bluff Park United Methodist Church have a holy opportunity to grow into a new future with hope.


