ear friends of Bluff Park UMC, we have had a wonderful response to the 10,000 Reasons, 1,500 Pieces, One Vision campaign. Commitment Sunday was on October 30th and that Sunday was our second highest attended Sunday of 2016 (only behind Easter Sunday). As I write to you on November 7th, we have had two Sundays for our church family to respond with pledges for our 2017 Annual Budget as well as to the 10,000 Reasons Capital Campaign. Our goal for the Capital Campaign was a three-year total pledge of \$1.6 million. In the first two Sundays of our commitment responses, we have received 173 pledges for the 10,000 Reasons Capital Campaign with a three-year total pledge of \$1,009,611. We are well on our way to our goal but all of us will

need to respond if we are to reach our goal!


Also, we have received 215 pledges for our 2017 Annual Budget with \$900,323 pledged to the budget. Compared to this time last year, we are \$50,000 ahead in pledged giving to the annual budget with only six additional pledges. We are off to a wonderful start but we will still need everyone to respond to the campaign so that we will be able to appropriately budget for our ministries next year. As our children's ministry continues to grow and as we prepare to launch a new worship service, we will have new expenses in 2017 to include in our budget.

I also wanted to share with all of you that our Board of Stewards unanimously approved our Phase 1 building project at the Charge Conference on Sunday evening, November 6th. This was a very important step for us as we prepare for construction next year of a new space for youth ministry, community ministry, and a new gymnasium. I am so very thankful that our church family is supporting our shared future and vision together. May God continue to fill us all with dreams and empower us to live them out together!
