ast week, I shared with you the second rule for general societies in the Methodist movement as written by John Wesley. By doing good, John Wesley instructed, we have the opportunity to be a blessing to God and others

Today, I want to go back and share the first rule for the general societies: Doing no harm. John Wesley advised that early Methodists should strive to avoid evil of every kind, "especially that which is most generally practiced." His emphasis on generally practiced evil was important. He wanted Methodist Christians to avoid living like everyone else. He didn't want us to blend in with culture, but to stand out as radically different.

Wesley advised early Methodists not to take the name of God in vain or to waste a Sabbath by doing ordinary work. He didn't want Methodists to buy or sell slaves or to take advantage of others through unfair interest in loans. He advised his people to avoid fighting, quarreling, brawling and other forms of taking a simple disagreement to the extreme. By avoiding evil of every kind, Wesley believed that we had a fighting chance at creating space for God and God's grace in our lives. And by seeking to do no harm to others, we could create space in our lives and activities for the second rule from last week: to do good.

In our culture today, we could all use a dose of the first two rules to help order our relationships — to do no harm and to do all the good we can.

The hope lies at the end of Lent - where we find that Jesus defeats death and sin and allows us the opportunity to renew our faith.
