"Staying in love with God" is how United Methodist Bishop Rueben Job describes the last of the three general rules for Methodist Societies as John Wesley designed them. We stay in love with God by following the third and final rule: "attending upon all the ordinances of God." These are the things that God has commanded us to do as His people and such we are developed and formed to be His people for the world.

These ordinances include attending worship, reading Scripture both as a group and personally in devotion, praying individually and as a community, celebrating Holy Communion and fasting. Each one of these requires one important thing: time. We are called and commanded to make time to spend with Him and with

others devoted to Him so that we can learn His beautiful story and what it means for all of us.

Each and every person desiring to have a meaningful relationship with a spouse, a child, or even a close friend has to invest the exact same thing: time. Each and every relationship requires time spent with one another so that we grow closer together. It is the exact same thing with our time with God. The good news from Bishop Job is that the more time we spend with God, honestly reflecting upon His love and character, the more we will fall in love with God.

North Alabama Conference Connectional Ministries staff. He has most recently served as the senior pastor at Trinity UMC in Huntsville, AL, and as a consultant with Resource Ministry Partners.

For centuries, Christians have begun a forty day season of spiritual preparation for Easter by observing a holy Lenten season. The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, which this year begins on March 1, 2017. For forty days (not counting Easter), we spend time dealing with the reality of our lives and contemplating the ways we separate ourselves from God. The hope lies at the end of Lent - where we find that Jesus defeats death and sin and allows us the opportunity to renew our faith. During this Lenten season, we will provide weekly prayers, daily Scripture readings and other ideas for spiritual disciplines. We hope that for this season of Lent, you will join us on this journey!
