he season of Lent already has a sense of seriousness about it, for we are dealing with our sin and our lack of faith. The final week of Lent takes on even a more

serious tone as we are set to follow Jesus into Jerusalem for the final time.

On Sunday, Holy Week begins with a celebration as we remember how the crowds welcomed Jesus into Jerusalem as he rode in upon a colt. Our children will gather to

wave palm branches just as those who walked ahead of Jesus shouted "Hosanna" and waved the branches of nearby palms. They anticipated that Jesus was about to say and do great things.

In his daily visits to the Temple, Jesus did say and do great things, but they were the kind of things that further drove a wedge between him and the establishment. Rather than to come and talk with Jesus and to see what he was doing, they plotted to silence him. They plotted to kill him.

During the next week, we invite you to come on this final journey with Jesus. We will have Maundy Thursday worship and Good Friday worship at 6:30 pm on both days in our Sanctuary. An optional yet wonderful service of foot washing will follow Thursday's service of Holy Communion. And of course, we gather together on Easter Sunday ~ to celebrate how God defeats death and dead ends in the resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Baundy Thursday Foot Washing Service Opportunity for Spiritual Growth and Blessing. In the 13th chapter of the Gospel of John we see Jesus humbly washing the feet of his disciples. This act of humility portrays Jesus' character and the character he desires for all of us believers. In this Scripture He commands all those who follow Him to do the same! "If I then, your Master and Rabbi, have washed your feet, it is also your duty to wash one another's feet. For I have set you an example in order that you may do what I have done to you." John 13:14-15. Just as Jesus washed the feet of His disciples, we believers are commanded to perform this same service, and many churches offer this opportunity during the yearly Easter observances. Following our Maundy Thursday Service at 6:30 p.m., April 13, our church will offer an opportunity for believers to follow Jesus' command to "do what I have done"—"to wash one another's feet" as each of us continues on his/her journey to become more "Christ-like." After Jesus' command to "do wash one another's feet" is this promise. "If you know all this, blessed are you if you act accordingly." The humble life of service exemplified in footwashing is in contrast to our former lives centered in pride and selfishness. See you at the Maundy Thursday Foot Washing Service!


