On Sunday, May 14th, we celebrated Mother's Day in worship and we finished our series called "Real Presence." For four Sundays, we looked into the ways in which Jesus' relationships with his disciples changed after his resurrection as well as what these encounters teach us about how to carry out our relationships. We learned that we should not give up too quickly with one another as Thomas almost did when he doubted Jesus' resurrection. We learned that we should not waste the precious time that we have with one another. There are so many temptations that take us away from the very people that God has blessed us with. We also learned that Jesus thought forgiveness was too important to skip over even after his resurrection. He and Peter found reconciliation at a breakfast by the Sea of Galilee.

After worship, my family went to lunch at a local restaurant in Vestavia Hills to celebrate my wife, Julie. It was such a pretty day that we decided to sit outside. Another family came and dined at a table behind us and as you can imagine you can sometimes hear the conversations of others when you are packed into tight spaces. About four times (that I heard), the discussion between a husband and wife descended into an argument right in front of their child. Each time one of them said, "we just don't need to keep talking about this on Mother's Day because we will just keep arguing." My heart broke for them and I prayed that the rest of the day would be better for them.

Friends, Jesus Christ models for us what our relationships can be like. Intimate friendship with his disciples; honest discussions with people like Nicodemus and a Samaritan woman at a well; and forgiveness offered to people seeking God. By investing in your relationship with him, you will be changing each and every relationship in your life and hopefully, as you do — the marvelous light of Christ will shine on others through you!
