A SUMMER OF MISSION WORK!

The work of the church does not take a summer vacation because the needs of our community continue throughout the year! As a community of faith we continue to provide food, water and shelter to people in need through our ongoing mission work.

From July 2-8 a team of youth and adult volunteers will head out to participate in the Appalachian Service Project. They will spend the week performing household repairs for people in central Appalachia. Their work will help families stay warmer, drier, and safer in their homes.

Here at home, we will continue to provide food and water to our neighbors in need through the Pantry on the Bluff and the Under the Bridge



program. The food pantry distribution takes place on the first Wednesday of each month and serves more than 200 families with food and diapers. Volunteers pack grocery bags, bundle diapers, and purchase food and stock shelves in the pantry. The Under the Bridge team prepares and serves meals for the homeless on the second and third Tuesdays of each month.

If you would like to serve this summer, the Pantry on the Bluff and Under the Bridge ministries are excellent opportunities to make a real difference for the people in our community.

Finally, a Volunteers In Ministry (VIM) team will set out for Chile at the end of July to roll up their sleeves and support our mission partners.



CHILDREN'S MISSION PROJECTS

The children's ministry keeps a mission focus throughout the summer. They have two mission projects where they will create artwork for the shut-ins of our community and purchase school supplies for kids in need in our school system.

During VBS, the children will take up a special offering to support the Room 35226 program.


