WE BELIEVE

The Apostles' Creed begins with the claim that there is one God who is Father Almighty and the maker of heaven and earth. When you first open up a Bible to the book of Genesis, you find a grand story about how God created the expanse of the universe. By the second chapter of Genesis, the focus of creation lands upon one human individual: Adam. God breathes life into him and thus begins a grand saga of the God of the universe loving His creatures and bringing them back home to Him. It's a story that proves, in theologian Karl Barth's mine, that if we even know that God exists then that proves that God loves us all.

While God loves us just the way we are, the old preacher says, God loves us too much to let us stay that way. The story of humanity is a continued story of turning in upon ourselves rather than turning towards God. Yes, there have been moments along the way of holy alignment with heaven. But there are so many more times in which we are opposed to heaven. And yet, the story goes that God continues to turn back to creation and back to His people urging them to return. There is a project afoot – a work from Heaven being done to transform us into who God calls us to be as His creatures.

God's project begins by showing us the way. And then, God provides God's own self in Jesus Christ to lead us the rest of the way. For the next four Sundays, we turn to the third of the Triune God whose story takes up the majority of the Apostles' Creed: Jesus Christ.
