he Board of Stewards met this past Sunday (on Father's Day Sunday) in order to discuss the steps we are about to take in moving forward with the construction of our new building. Our church approved moving forward with the plans many months ago, but the new contract allows us to start with clearing the land at the beginning of August and thus move forward with construction through the fall and winter. The budget for construction will be \$2.1 million so we will need everyone to continue to faithfully give to the 10,000 Reasons Capital Campaign. We had over \$1 million pledged over the next three years and over \$200,000 has already been offered to propel us forward. If you have not been able to pledge to this important campaign, there is still time to do so! You can simply call the church's financial office staff or come by and fill out a card.

The new worship service (The Gathering at Bluff Park) is moving ahead after having a wonderful preview worship service on Easter Sunday with 115 in attendance! Our launch team is made up of some great young people and they are working on offering a weekly worship service sometime after Labor Day Weekend! If you know of anyone who is interested in this new offering or who is passionate about assisting in the creation of the new service, we would love to be able to talk to them about the possibilities for service and support.

Finally, we are continuing in our summer sermon series on the Apostles' Creed as Rev. Tom Duley explores the birth of Jesus Christ on June 25th and as I explore the suffering of Jesus at the hands of the Roman Empire and Pontius Pilate on Sunday, July 2nd. We have noticed that our first sermon on "God the Father Almighty" has had a great response online as many people who missed that first Sunday were able to go watch the sermon on Youtube. Don't forget that we offer many different options for catching up on the Sundays that you have missed due to vacation or other circumstances!
