n Sunday in worship, we begin a two-week sermon series entitled "We Can Work It Out." The intent is to look into the ways that the early church advised Christians to deal with conflict and controversy. While this advice can lead to stronger relationships and the blessings of living in a reconciled community, it is also advice that runs counter to our initial instincts. We often want to shut down opposing opinions or dissent. While this may seem like the right way forward, I have found in my own life is that I am not always the best judge of what is right and true. I need the voices of others who see the world from a different vantage point so that I may either grow and mature in faith and life or that I may come to a stronger conviction of the position I already held.

It is possible for us to be divided in some opinions and united in a shared mission. However, it is also possible to become divided as a family or even as a community if we can not find ways to work out the core issues we are facing. My hope and prayer is that no matter what - we can all work it out over time. I believe that it is possible because it has been done before and because we find in the early church that they cherished so deeply a church (a united body of Christ) committed to one another even through the darkest of times.

It takes a lot of emotional and spiritual energy to do as Paul guides us and "bear with one another" as Colossians 3 tells us. But that energy is well spent if it leads to a church united!
