When you know someone is about to come over, how do you prepare for their visit? Do you clean the house? Vacuum the floors? Hide all of the unorganized clutter? We literally make room for our guests — making sure that it feels that their visit was anticipated and that we wanted our home to be in the best shape for them.

Advent is a little like that. We are literally preparing for "the coming" (advent) of Jesus. We are preparing to receive Jesus as the Christ child on Christmas Day and we are also preparing to receive him when he returns as our victorious King. We are invited by the Scriptures to not only make room for him in our lives and in our world – but we are also invited to clean up before he arrives.

We often read passages from John the Baptist in Advent. It makes sense because his birth is directly tied to Jesus' birth in the Gospels. But the texts we read contain things that John said when he was in his thirties. He talks about cleaning up our lives in order to prepare for the arrival of the Messiah who is coming soon. He says that we should repent and be baptized. We should get our hearts out of a self-interest mode and become more generous and caring (giving away what we do not actually need).

Cleaning up the chaos, getting rid of the clutter, and making room for God in our lives. This is the strange work of Advent. Work that we are tasked with as everything else in our lives directs us towards acquiring more and more. Let us as a church focus on having a Holy Advent – cleaning and preparing and making room for the one who will surely come to us!
