uthor Steve Harper reminds us that buildings "last because they rest upon solid foundations." Think about those great buildings that have lasted throughout history. They endure because they have been built to last. Jesus taught that buildings that are built upon the rock will endure the storms that life throws our way while buildings built upon sand will crumble and tumble as those same storms unleash their chaos upon the structure. Dr. Harper believes, along with Jesus, that our lives are similar to buildings. We need a solid foundation to build our life upon.

John Wesley taught that Methodists should be the kind of Christians who love God and love their neighbor. Notice the upward and outward focus for our lives as disciples: love goes upwards to the God who grants us mercy and love

goes outward to the people we need to show mercy. A life well-built is a life that has daily practices of loving God and loving our neighbor.
