e had such a wonderful Celebration Sunday and we were so very honored to have both Dr. Leonard Sweet and Dr. Ron Martoia with us in Traditional Worship and in The Gathering. It was such a moving experience to admit that we stand on the shoulders of giants from the past and present of Bluff Park UMC. People of faith dreamed dreams and had visions of what might be and we entered into sanctuaries and hallways that others built for us. And we are in the business of being the stewards of these holy spaces for the sake of the people who will come after us as well as the people who God is calling to join us even now.

Dr. Leonard Sweet challenged us to consider that the children that we are reaching right now have a life expectancy that is higher than people of previous

We discussed how God's saving grace is far reaching into our lives: as our heart chooses God and as our lives are transformed into the image of Christ. The work of Confirmation is the work of the church becoming new and young again. But they cannot be all that God calls them to be without your continued love and Christian witness. God gives you and me dreams and visions. Why? So that God can work through each of us to bring forth spaces like our new building where lives can be transformed. But God also gives us these dreams and visions so that we can inspire and pass on our faith to the next generation. For this century and the next.


