ent has begun at Bluff Park United Methodist as we celebrated Ash Wednesday together this past Wednesday evening in our Sanctuary. The season of Lent is a time of spiritual assessment and spiritual renovation. We look honestly at ourselves, putting aside any false self or mask that we might wear in public. And we evaluate what within us needs the light of God the

most so that God's light can drive away the darkness that has crept into our lives. We do this as we move closer and closer to Easter so that when we celebrate that Jesus has defeated death and sin and risen from the tomb we might be more ready to greet him.

Lent lasts forty days which is the same number of days that Jesus spent in the wilderness fasting and the same number of days that Noah was on the ark as the rains came down upon the earth. Ash Wednesday fell on February 14 and Easter Sunday will be on April 1. If you were to get out your calendar or ask Siri how many days fall between now and Easter you might think that I could not count. There are more than forty days in Easter, you might say! Well, there are days that do not count.

Sundays in Lent remain "feast days." We worship God on Sunday and are allowed a "break" from our Lenten disciplines so that we can come together to celebrate. During this Lenten season, we will focus on this concept of feasting together and celebrating God at Bluff Park UMC by having more frequent Holy Communion together. Just as families join around the dinner table, our church family can gather around the Lord's table in our Sanctuary and Chapel on Sundays so that we can thank God for grace, love, friends and for this season to remake who we can and should be in the light of God's love.
