e are moving through the season of Lent and have shared time together at the Lord's Table for three Sundays in a row. This might have felt like a surprise for many of you, but the concept of treating each and every Sunday as a festive celebration is not new at all. Sundays throughout the year are described as "little Easters" by some in church history.

The idea is that the Sunday worship service is the place in which we (week after week) come together as a gathering of God's people to celebrate that God has raised Jesus Christ from the dead.

The season of Lent is a great place to see this in action. We tell you each and every year at the beginning of Lent that it is a season of forty days of spiritual growth. For those of you who have not actually looked at the calendar, you may not have noticed that there are more than forty days between Ash Wednesday and Easter Sunday. And why is that? It is because Sundays do not count in the forty days of Easter as they are days for worshipping God and celebrating together that Jesus is risen.

In a way, keeping the Sabbath holy takes precedence over the practice of celebrating a holy Lent. And celebrating together as a church family at God's table (the altar table) is a subtle reminder of this truth. God's command for us to gather together in worship and celebrate what God has and will do for us is a very vital part of our life together as a church family. I hope that this season of Lent is very meaningful to each and every one of you and that you find yourself closer to God and to one another!
