elcome to Holy Week 2018! I hope this week is a time spent in prayer and reflection for you whether you are here in town or whether you are away for Spring Break. Because it is Spring Break, we will not have our Midweek Meetup this Wednesday evening. We will have Holy Week worship services in the main Sanctuary on Maun-

dy Thursday and on Good Friday. These services are always such meaningful and powerful ways of putting ourselves into the place of Jesus during this time of faithfulness, sorrow and hope. If you are not in town for Holy Week, I hope you will consider joining the LifeTrack Daily e-mail devotional so that you can engage with the Scriptures and prayers to help guide you through this special week.

During his final week, Jesus spent a lot of time in the Temple in Jerusalem confronting the religious leaders and the ways in which the people were distracted from seeing him for who he is and from living the way that God called His people to live. The Temple was such a busy place, which makes me realize that spiritually distracted people can be doing things that they think are important and vital but end up being the opposite of what God would have us do. People were coming and going...but were not technically growing. The season of Lent is a season of focus. We give up our distractions by taking on something that helps us focus on God or by giving up something that distracts our hearts from God. If you have not been able to find focus this Lent, I hope you will give it a try beginning this Palm Sunday. May your soul find focus and rest as you walk in the footsteps of Christ in this holy season.
