


Message from the Pastor

CAMP ON THE BLUFF

At one time, June was a quiet month for the Children's Ministry area of Bluff Park UMC. With school out and Midweek Meetups over for the summer, the staff and volunteers spent time gearing up for Vacation Bible School in July. But, in June of 2017, we began to offer a free Summer Camp for kids in our community and in 2018 the program has nearly doubled.

According to Stanley Davidson, the Director of Children's Ministry, Sunday mornings in the Summer become mini-reunions for the kids. They don't see each other at school or Midweek activities, so they spend the time catching up with each other and trading news about their summer activities. Most of the conversations revolve around the various summer camps the kids are attending. But, Stanley noticed that there were always a few kids who were left out of the conversation because they weren't able to attend a camp. "I figured, if there were kids in our church who didn't have a summer camp to go too, there must be others in our community as well. I thought we should do something special for those kids."

Stanley brought a proposal to the Children's Council to create a summer camp that teaches basic skills in areas like basketball and gardening along with the basics of the Christian faith. From that idea, Camp on the Bluff was born.

When registration for the first camp was opened in 2017, all 60 spaces were filled in 45 minutes. The campers who signed up included church members, kids from the Bluff Park community, and also a group of kids from the Riley Center in Birmingham. The program was expanded to accommodate 100 kids in 2018 and it still filled up in under 24 hours.

A group of dedicated volunteers are at the heart of this program. They donate their time to share their passion with the kids. Stanley makes sure that the kids leave knowing God created them, God loves them, Jesus saves them, and that they can share the love of God with others.

According to Stanley, the program is working well. We are seeing families of campers return for other events at the church and getting more involved with our children's ministry. And the kids are having a great time!

Camp on the Bluff runs from June 18-21. Please keep the children, our volunteers, and staff in your prayers.









CHILDREN'S MINISTRY



Exciting things are happening in the Children's Ministry this month! To begin with, Children's Church will be partnering with our traditional worship services in June on a sermon series called "Incredibles Too!" Each week in June, either Rev. Mike Holly or Rev. Angela Martin will be preaching in our traditional worship services on a hero of the Old Testament, and I will be preaching on the same hero in Children's Church! Because both the adults and children will be hearing the same things in church during June, we will be offering "Family Discussion Postcards" as a way to help families discuss, put into action, and dig deeper into what they are learning in church. Each postcard includes discussion questions that families can talk about at any time throughout the week, as well as a possible family activity that families can do together to dig deeper into and put into action what they are learning. These cards can be picked up at the Welcome Desk, or when your child is picked up from Children's Church, on each Sunday during the month of June.

We will also spend the month of June planning for and leading Camp on the Bluff! You can read more about this exciting event on page three of the Newsletter. Further, we already have 175 children from our church and community registered for our Vacation Bible School, and we are expecting record breaking numbers again this year! We will be spending June putting final plans in place for VBS and getting ready for the arrival of the children on July 16-20. 
