This is such a wonderful time of year. Football is back and we are finally getting used to our new rhythms and schedules. While it is an exciting time, there is also a lot to accomplish.

I found this information very helpful when I read it and I hope it is helpful to you!

What can you do to find the balance between what you need to do and what you



would like to do? How do you deal with those moments where you feel overwhelmed?

I will confess to you that I do not have it all figured out. But I do have a few things to suggest that might be helpful.

1. You do not have to do it all - You and your family will not be scarred for life if you do not get to do it all. You will not be missing out if you do not have everything that the neighbor down the street has either. When a new year starts, one of the best things you can do is to set realistic expectations and learn to have a strategic "no" ready to go.

2. Take some time for yourself - It's not selfish to take some time for yourself every now and then. 
