





Message from the Pastor

It seems like it was only a year or so ago that we started this decade. Now we are about to begin on the final year of the 2010s. This has been a decade of dramatic shifts in culture and technology. At the same time, we still face age-old human issues. For the past two months, the men's study that I am a part of has been studying 1 and 2 Kings from the Old Testament. Over and over again, we read about how the kings of Israel and Judah forgot about their primary roles and began to operate in opposition to God. You see, the kings were to lead the people towards God and they were to shepherd the people. Instead, other gods were worshipped and money was redirected from the poor to those in power. They forgot about God to the point at which they even misplaced the Scriptures!



Once they found the Scriptures, they slowly began to make a new start together as a people. A new year is a good time for a new start, isn't it? We attempt it every year with a resolution or a promise to ourselves. When it comes to our faith journey, we can make several decisions to start the year off on the right foot:

1) We can read the Bible more frequently. Sign up for the LifeTrack daily devotional readings or join the Bishop of the North Alabama Conference in reading through the Bible in one year.

2) We can commit to staying in love with God through our habits and practices. During the months of January and February, we will be highlighting the Means of Grace which not only help us connect with God and His grace, but they also keep God in our vision so that we are less likely to go astray. We will discuss a different means of grace in Traditional Worship and there is even a study available for Sunday School classes or for a Midweek Meetup class.

So, how are you going to make a commitment to start 2019 off on the right foot? Don't forget to get an accountability partner who can lovingly remind you of your commitment!

We believe that to grow toward becoming fully-formed disciples of Christ, we must be life-long learners. The opportunities listed here offer us the chance to learn about God and each other through holistic study and fellowship. By learning together, we grow together as a community and we grow stronger in our relationship with and understanding of God.


