In the seventeenth chapter of John's Gospel, Jesus prays for his disciples as well as his future disciples. I have always been encouraged to read Jesus' prayer as a prayer for you and for me. Over and over again in this prayer, Jesus prays for our unity. He prays for us to be completely one.

While we are a somewhat diverse Church, we all belong to the same community and to



this particular Body of Christ. Over the summer, we have joined together the 8:45 and 11:00 am Traditional Worship services into one service at 10:00 am. I have heard so many of you say that while you appreciated the flexibility that having two worship options each Sunday, you appreciated, even more, the opportunity to worship as one. Through a prayerful process of seeking feedback from Sunday School classes, Common Tables, committees and from the community, we have decided to continue to have one unified Traditional Worship service this fall.

The shared worship hour for this fall will be at 10:30 am. This includes Traditional Worship as well as The Gathering, our modern worship service in the Chapel. Because of this change, we will be moving our Sunday School time to 9:15 am. Of course, our nursery, as well as our elementary and youth departments, will open up at 9:00 am for early drop off of children. This new schedule begins on Sunday, September 8, 2019.

While this is a big change for our church family, it is a way for us to continue to be one. One in community and one in Christ.

The New Light class and BPUMC Mission Fund have already sponsored the drilling of 2 wells. 52 families no longer worry about finding clean water to drink.
